Judith Whittick is a pioneering woman leader in the STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) disciplines, having served as president and chief executive officer of engineering R&D organization C-CORE from 1997-2006. She is an honorary member of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland, and an honorary member of the Engineering Institute of Canada in recognition of her contribution to the engineering profession. Judith is also a recipient of the 1999 United States MMS Corporate Leadership Award from Minerals Management Services, US Department of the Interior. She served on the national advisory board of the Canadian Space Agency and the National Research Council Industrial Assistance Program.

Judith continues to show leadership in many other spheres. She has chaired over 20 peer review panels for the federal government program Networks of Centre of Excellence, and is also an active volunteer in the East Coast Trail Association, securing major funding and developing trail enhancement and maintenance programs.

In encouraging women on the leadership path, Judith will share the wisdom of her personal experience and will invite dialogue with participants.
